85% of members rate the credit union's community support as "excellent" or "very good"






Giving back to the Givers.




Sharing our time and expertise.

Community Perks at the Arrowhead Clubhouse.



Arrowhead Clubhouse is one of 35 programs operated by Sunshine Coast Community Services Society.

Arrowhead Clubhouse is an inclusive community of hope where individuals find encouragement, opportunities, a sense of ownership and belonging. In 2017, a member of Arrowhead Clubhouse asked for help with a challenge he was facing. He needed to purchase a saw, a requirement to fulfill his job as an assistant carpenter.

In October 2018, Sunshine Coast Credit Union was proud to offer a grant to Arrowhead Clubhouse to launch the *Employment Essentials Fund*. This fund helps members of the Clubhouse, who have secured employment in our community, purchase items or tools that are necessary for their job.


By the end of 2018, 14 members had used the fund to purchase a total of \$1,264 in work equipment, from work boots to protective glasses.
