National Day for Truth and Reconciliation Message from the CEO

The federal government announced that the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation would be recognized on September 30th as a statutory holiday for federal employees. While this statutory holiday does not specifically apply to our organization as a provincially-regulated credit union, Sunshine Coast Credit Union is committed to commemorate and honour residential school survivors - and those who did not survive - their families and Indigenous communities in a meaningful way. With this, we have respectfully chosen to close our branches and administration office to support our employees in a day of reflection and learning. We believe that actions are an important part of reconciliation. For this reason, an employee-led team is curating and providing all SCCU staff with a collection of Indigenous educational material as part of our collective learning on that day.

Our credit union operates on the traditional territory of both the shíshálh (Sechelt) and the Sk̓wxwú7mesh (Squamish) First Nations. Our Sechelt branch is within walking distance to where St. Augustine's Residential School once stood. We close on this day in honour of our Indigenous members, employees and community and to give time for non-Indigenous individuals to reflect on our history and the impact it has had on Indigenous people. We will embrace this opportunity to better understand and move toward reconciliation, together.
